Application

I am looking at postdoc position at FSMP and I want to know when and where the Call is published?

The call is published at the beginning of October on the web site of the Fondation as well as on the website of MathJobs (<https://www.mathjobs.org/>).

I have defended my PhD in one of the affiliated laboratories of FSMP and I'm wondering if I am eligible to apply for the Postdoc position FSMP call?

Unfortunately, you are not eligible to apply for the Postdoc position of the FSMP call.

Frequently question related to the Documents uploaded :

I read on the Call condition that I have to submit a scientific project which must be a maximum of 6 pages. Should the list of references be included within the maximum 6 pages or can it be considered separately?

The list of the reference shouldn't be included in the 6 pages of the scientific project. It can be considered separately.

Recommendation letters :

We strongly advise you to check that all recommendation letters indicated in the Call conditions are uploaded in your application before the Call deadline.

How can I check if my professors did upload a letter?

All your documents are available in your application with your login and your password and you can check them as long as the Call is open. However, you cannot read or delete letters of recommendation.

FAQ POST-DOC

Frequently question related to the Call results :

Do you know when the results of post-doc position FSMP will be known? I cannot find this information on the website.

The list of laureates for the postdoctoral position of the FSMP Call is published on the website FSMP at the beginning of February (after the selection procedure has been completed).

I haven't received any email from the hiring committee yet. Does that mean I am not on the list of laureates?
